## Disabled Student Programs and Services

### Developmentally Delayed Learner Disability Verification

Developmentally Delayed Learner (DDL) is defined as learning deficits resulting from below average intellectual functioning which adversely affects educational performance, existing concurrently with measurable potential for achievement in educational and/or employment settings.

This disability can be verified by the Disabled Student Programs Services (DSPS) Coordinator or a DDL Specialist using the documentation from a referring agency. The student is eligible by meeting one of the three standards described below:

- The student has an earned standard score of less than or equal to 70 on the specified ability assessment procedure.

- dependent/semi-independent living environment,
- client status with the state Department of Rehabilitation,
- client status with the Regional Center, or
- academic skill deficiency.

For scores greater than 80, the assessment procedure's standard error of measurement may be considered.
