### “GREAT START” Steps for First-Time College Students and \*Reentry Students

**STEP 1: Submit an admission application and official (sealed) transcripts from high school/college.** Bring official (sealed) transcripts with you if there is insufficient time to have them mailed to the Records office. You may apply online at <http://www.cccapply.org>, beginning **October 1** for the spring 2010 term. This request will NOT be processed if you have not submitted an admission application to Cuesta College. Please bring your Cuesta College ID number with you. See below for next steps.

**\*Attention Reentry Students:** If you have already completed college-level English courses, you are not required to complete Step 2–Assessment Testing, but must submit official transcripts from other colleges/universities to the Records office.

**Assessment Services**

**First-time college or Reentry students** are expected to complete their English assessment test prior to registering. A reentry student is any person 25 years or older who has been out of school for 5 or more years.

Assessment placement results will assist students with appropriate course selection and may be used to satisfy mandatory course prerequisites. There is no fee for English assessment test. English assessment consists of a written essay followed by a math test. Testing will last approximately 2 1/2 hours. Students signing up for a Great Start Workshop are expected to participate in English and math assessment testing followed by orientation. Be prompt! You will not be admitted if you are late.

Cuesta College accepts English assessment and course placement scores from other California community colleges, UC or CSU campuses with no time limits. Math assessment and course placement scores from these institutions must be current within the past 18 months. Mail or fax (805) 546-3113 test results from other schools to Cuesta College Assessment Office, P.O. Box 8106, San Luis Obispo CA 93403-8106.

If you are submitting recent assessment scores from another college, you may participate in the above orientation and need not sign-up for the assessment testing portion. Check the box above to sign-up for orientation only.

**Alternatives to taking the English or math test:**

**ENGLISH**

- Earn "ready for CSU college – level English courses" status on the EAP exam
- Score a 680 or above on the SAT English exam
- Score a 24 or above on the ACT English exam
- Pass the AP English Language or Literature Composition Exam with a score of 3 or above
- Submit results from completed English assessment/placement exam taken at another California public college or university AND submit copy of high school transcripts

**MATH**

- Earn "ready for CSU college-level math courses" status on the EAP exam
- Score a 550 or above on the SAT Math exam
- Score a 23 or above on the ACT Math exam
- Pass the AP Calculus AB exam or AP Statistics exam with a score of 3 or above
- Submit results from completed math assessment/placement exam taken at another California public college or university AND copy of high school transcripts
- Earn a 'C' or better grade in a mathematics course taken at another college or university AND submit copy of college/university transcript with Prerequisites Form A
