Cuesta College kicks off the new 2007/2008 academic year on Monday, August 20! Fall 2007 Semester at Cuesta College begins August 20 and ends December 21, 2007

Classes are offered in Paso Robles on the North County Campus, in South County at Arroyo Grande High School and Nipomo High School, and in San Luis Obispo on the San Luis Campus. Each campus provides the required coursework to give students the opportunity to earn an on-site Associates Degree.

Approximately 10,050 students have already registered for courses at Cuesta College this semester, an increase of nearly 600 students from this time last year. Approximately 2,500 of those students will be taking classes at the North County Campus, an increase of more than 330 students from this time last year.

New or former Cuesta students who have been absent two or more consecutive semesters must submit an admission application prior to registering. Students may apply now online at www.cuesta.edu. Fall 2007 Class Schedules are available at all Cuesta campuses and have also been distributed throughout San Luis Obispo County at libraries and chamber of commerce offices. Deadline to late register with instructor permission for a full-semester class is Saturday, September 1, 2007.

To late register, students must obtain an add card signed by the instructor for walk-in registration (admission applications are accepted at walk-in registration) or an add code to register online by WEBReg.
