# Cuesta College to Host Screening of Hollywood Documentary at Banned Books Week

The Cuesta College Library will exclusively host the Central Coast premiere of a traveling documentary portraying the real-life duties of librarians in contrast to their depiction in Hollywood.

The documentary, “The Hollywood Librarian: A look at librarians through film” was written and directed by a veteran librarian-turned-producer and was screened in June at the American Library Association’s annual conference in Washington, D.C. The feature length film will premiere at select libraries and schools across the country, including Cuesta College, from September 29 to October 6 in conjunction with National Banned Books Week. Following the nationwide tour, the documentary will show on the film festival circuit and premiere in select movie theaters.

“The Hollywood Librarian” will show at Cuesta College’s newly renovated library on Sunday, September 30 at 2 p.m. and 4 p.m., and on Wednesday, October 3 at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. Tickets cost \$8 for adults and \$5 for children and seniors.
