# Cal Poly Students Present Ways to Improve Public Transit to Cuesta College at Exhibition

Cal Poly Civil Engineering students will present their ideas for public transportation serving Cuesta College via the possible redesign of the Regional Transit Authority Bus Route 12A and more at an exhibition at Cuesta College on Thursday, November 20. The event is free of charge and open to the public.

The students in Eugene Jud's Public Transportation class were asked to create a proposal to amend the current problem of overcrowding on the RTA bus that serves Cuesta College. Groups had to balance current community concerns with increasing gas prices and economic problems that affect how Cuesta students travel to school.

"Good ideas can come from anywhere," said Jud. "These students are the engineers of tomorrow and they have an impact on how San Luis Obispo County will look in the future."

At the exhibition, each group will give a short presentation and guests are invited to discuss the displays with the students. Each project presents a general idea for the Regional Transportation Authority and Cuesta College in the short term (2015) and long term (2050), addressing the possible changes in the public transit routes that serve the corridor between Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo, and beyond.

The transportation exhibition will be held at Cuesta College in the Professional Development Center, Room 3142. The exhibition will open at 3:45 with presentations to follow from 4:00 to 5:15 p.m.
