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# Student Entries Now Accepted for Short Attention Span Digital Video Festival

Student filmmakers can put that MTV-bred, short attention span and love for video to good use at the 2009 Short Attention Span Digital Video Festival (SASDVF). Submission entries for the festival will be accepted from graduate students, undergraduate college students and high school students through June 12.

The event will be held in November at the Art Institute of Boston and later, in March of 2010, in San Luis Obispo. SASDVF entries will then travel to Los Angeles, Santa Cruz and San Francisco.

All films are limited to a total running time (excluding credits) of 20 minutes or less, and the festival is open to any student.

The festival will be judged by a qualified, multi-person jury who will determine the top winner in the graduate, undergraduate and high school, animation and fiction categories.

The event is sponsored by the Art Institute of Boston, Cuesta College and the Palm Theatre in San Luis Obispo. The entry fee is \$25, and all entries must be submitted in DVD format.
