## **Cuestonian Earns Honors at Annual College Journalism Convention**

Cuesta College's student newspaper and Web site earned honors at the Associated Collegiate Press Journalism Convention held recently in San Diego.

The Cuestonian was the only community college Web site in the nation recognized for its interactive element at the 25<sup>th</sup> annual convention, held Feb. 26 to March 1 at Marriott Mission Valley San Diego. Student Jeremiah Lee of Fresno is the online editor. Patrick Howe, Cuesta journalism instructor and managing editor of New Times, works with students on the online edition.

The Cuestonian's Web site finished fourth behind three four-year schools: The Orion, California State University at Chico; UC Berkeley's The Daily Californian; and The Collegian at California State University at Fresno.

The Cuestonian's print edition and its editor, Travis Bland of Camarillo, were also honored. The publication was among eight two-year colleges to earn awards. Cuesta instructor Mary McCorkle is the newspaper adviser.

Cuesta's Web site and the newspaper were entered in the Best of Show competition along with student newspapers from across the nation.
