

NONDISCRIMINATION IN DISTRICT COLLEGE PROGRAMS	1570

The Board of Trustees of the San Luis Obispo County Community College District affirms that no person shall, on the basis of race, color, religious beliefs, gender, national origin, ethnicity, age, mental or physical disabilities, veteran status, sexual orientation, or marital status be unlawfully subject to discrimination under any program or activity of the San Luis Obispo County Community College District. (Title 5, Sections 59300-59362)

All programs and activities shall be available to all qualified persons without regard to race, color, religious beliefs, gender, national origin, ethnicity, age, mental or physical disabilities, veteran status, sexual orientation, or marital status. No person shall be denied the benefits of any community college program or activity on the basis of race, color, religious beliefs, gender, national origin, ethnicity, age, mental or physical disabilities, veteran status, sexual orientation, or marital status.

The College shall investigate complaints of unlawful discrimination in its program or activities and seek to resolve those complaints. The District employee responsible for insuring District compliance shall be the Director of Human Resources, who will notify students and employees of the provisions of this board policy.

Procedures for investigating complaints will be as outlined in Board Policy 1565, Unlawful Discrimination Grievance Procedure. Complaints must be submitted within one year from the date that the individual knew or should have known of the alleged incident(s) leading to the complaint.
