Access to the Course:

You can log into the course on the first day of the semester; you can NOT access the course before the semester starts!

To log in go to <http://blackboard.cuesta.edu> and follow the instructions; there is also now a direct link to Blackboard on our Cuesta.edu home page (<http://cuesta.edu>). It is located on the lower right hand corner of the page.

- Your login ID matches your Banner/my.cuesta ID: firstname_lastname (all lower case). The default password for Blackboard is STUDENT (all upper case). Change

your password once you have logged in. Passwords for my.cuesta and Blackboard can be set to be the same, that is your choice. If you have taken a course before, through Blackboard/WebCT, you will use your existing password.
