- Your login ID matches your Banner/my.cuesta ID: `firstname_lastname` (all lowercase). The default password for Blackboard is `STUDENT` (all upper case). Change your password once you have logged in. Passwords for my.cuesta and Blackboard can be set to be the same; it is your choice. If you have taken a course before, through Blackboard/WebCT, you will use your existing password.
